## NOTIFICATION

The Governor of Tripura, in continuation of notification No.F.3(352)-HFW/1999 dated 13.07.2015, is pleased to make the following guidelines on private practice of Medical Officers who have opted as per Rules of Tripura Health Service, 1974.

- 1. The doctors who apply for private practice shall submit details as at Annexure-I along with the prescribed application form.
- The doctors shall not do private practice for more than 3 hours on working days and 6 hours on holidays. The timings should be prominently displayed outside the private chamber.
- 3. No patient should be directed, advised or enticed from any Government hospital to visit private clinic of any Government doctor or charged fees from such patients.
- 4. No doctor permitted to do private practice shall sit or associate/practice with any polyclinic, private nursing home or laboratory.
- 5. Private practice permitted doctors shall maintain the dairy of patients with details of diagnosis, treatment prescribed and fees charged from each patient.
- 6. Every doctor shall give a receipt to every patient attended by him in his private chamber.
