
NOTIFICATION

Subject:- Tripura State NEET PG (MD/MS) and PG Diploma Counselling 2022.

1. The cut off date for eligibility of receiving incentive for Govt. Service in Rural/Difficult/Remote areas for in-service candidates from Appointing Authority/DHS is fixed on 30/4/2022. The cut off date for completion of internship for NEET PG 2022 candidates shall be 31/5/2022.
2. Incentive shall be given to only Tripura Govt. In-service candidates as per norms for serving in Rural/Difficult/Remote areas and as Notified by State Govt/Competent Authority from time to time and as issued by Appointing Authority/DHS for issuance of awarding incentive to the eligible candidates of NEET PG 2022.



Subject : Tripura State PG (MD/MS) and PG Diploma Courses Counseling 2022

The Tripura State PG(MD/MS) and PG Diploma Courses Counseling 2022 for selection of eligible candidates for admission in PG(MD/MS) and Diploma courses for session 2022 shall be made as follows:


1. Students for Post Graduate Medical courses shall be selected strictly on the basis of their Inter-se Academic Merit in NEET PG 2022 through single point entry.
2. State -wise merit list of the eligible candidates (i.e candidates who have obtained cut off marks as applicable for their category for the corresponding counseling) shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in NEET PG Entrance test and candidates shall be admitted to PG courses from the said merit list only
3. **No candidate (Open/ in-service) who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks as prescribed in Sub clause (3) of Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 shall be admitted to any PG courses in the said academic year**
4. In determining the Merit of Candidates who are in Service of Government/Public authority, the weightage in the marks will be given to only those candidates who are eligible as per the cut off marks required for the corresponding counseling as applicable for their category. Incentive marks for having served in Govt. Service in remote / difficult/ rural areas will be given to those candidates who have obtained prescribed cut off marks as fixed by the MCC / NMC / MoHFW for the corresponding counseling of the academic session. The provision of incentive mark shall follow the guideline of NMC as follows :-
" provided that in determining the merit of candidates who are in service of government/public authority , weight-age in the marks may be given by the Government / Competent Authority as an incentive up to an incentive up to 10% of the marks obtained for each year of service in remote and / or difficult areas or Rural areas up to maximum of 30% of the marks obtained in NEET (PG). The remote and / or difficult areas or Rural areas shall be as notified by State Government / Competent Authority from time to time"
It implies that **incentive marks for in service candidates, under provision to Clause 9(4) of PGME regulations can be given only to those candidates who have received minimum eligibility cut-off marks as prescribed under Clause 9(3) of the regulations .**
5. Reservation of seats for Post graduate Degree (MD/MS) Course and Diploma Course along with NEET UG (MBBS/BDS) Courses for the academic session 2022-23 and onwards will be distributed as per 100 point Roster and will be followed for each subject/Discipline separately like previous years 2020 & 2021. The said seats of the Institution/Medical Colleges to be fixed in 100 point roster as per discipline/subject will be in accordance with maintaining chronology of (1) Regional Institute of Medical Science, Imphal, Manipur (2) Agartala Government Medical College, Tripura (3) Tripura Medical College & DR. BRAM Teaching Hospital, Hapania respectively. Strict observation of the applicable reservation rules of the State shall be in force.



6. For Post Graduate Diploma Courses, 50% of seats shall be reserved for medical officers in Government Service who have served for at least 03 (three) years in Remote/Difficult/Rural areas in Tripura. **But while preparing merit list for such PG diploma Courses no incentive marks will be awarded.**
7. The Selection of Candidates against a State Quota seat will be as per seat matrix, State Eligibility, Merit, State reservation rules and fulfilment of Eligibility Criteria as prescribed in the Information Bulletin of NEET PG 2022 exam. For State Counselling/Selection/Nomination/Admission of a candidate for State Quota Seats/non Govt. seats, the jurisdiction of court cases/disputes shall be at Agartala only.
8. Any amendment/modification in the PGME regulations as adopted by NMC/MCC/MoHFW (GoI) from time to time shall be applicable on the State PG counselling for the corresponding year.
9. Category of a candidate (ST/SC/EWS/PWD) registered during NEET PG/Diploma entrance examination 2022 shall be treated as final and cannot be modified/corrected subsequently during State Counselling. Further, no claim in this regard shall be entertained.





NOTIFICATION

The Eligibility Criteria for appearing for NEET UG 2022 and Eligibility Criteria for State Eligibility for Domicile seats as well as Eligibility Criteria for admission to respective Institutions shall determine the ultimate eligibility of a candidate to get a seat accordingly as per merit and seat matrix for admission to UG (MBBS, BDS, BASLP/BHMS/BAMS) courses for the academic session 2022.

The Eligible Criteria for appearing for NEET PG 2022 and Eligibility Criteria for State Eligibility for domicile seats as well as Eligibility Criteria for admission to respective Institutions shall determine the ultimate eligibility of a candidate to get a seat accordingly as per merit and seat matrix for admission to PG (MD/MS/Post MBBS Diploma courses) for the academic session 2022.


For State Quota seats and Tripura govt. seats (for State quota/domicile candidate), the seats will be distributed in the counselling as per merit and seat matrix as per Tripura State Reservation Rules. For seats for All India Candidates other than Tripura domicile, the seat will be distributed as per merit and seat matrix as per Central Reservation Rules.

EWS, WESM and PWD reservation will be followed as per guideline accordingly.

Only registered eligible candidates for the Tripura State NEET PG (MD/MS) 2022 and Tripura state NEET UG 2022 Counselling will be eligible for participating in the said Counselling respectively.

The selection/Nomination/Admission against any UG or PG seats in respect to a candidate shall be cancelled at any point of time if a candidate is found to have submitted any false/fabricated/erased/incomplete/indistinct/untraced documents or any false information in obtaining eligibility for NEET UG 2022, NEET PG 2022 examination/ registration for counselling/Selection/Nomination/Admission to be allotted courses to the allotted Institutions and in such cases the candidate will not be permissible and shall be debarred to participate further in the counselling for the entire academic session.

The Principal/Head/Medical Superintendent of admitting institutions shall send the total list of admitted/nominated candidates of a particular round immediately after last date and time of admission with Roll Number. All India Rank, Category and Sub-Category (if any) along with number of vacant seats available to the Directorate of Medical Education. The Institutions shall communicate, send information to Directorate of Medical Education the Institutions shall communicate, admission related matters of candidates as and when sought from the Directorate of Medical Education, Government of Tripura.



MEMORANDUM

Sub:- Guidelines for issuing "No-objection certificate" in respect of Medical Officers of Tripura Health Services/Tripura Medical Education(Faculty and condition) services for appearing in Post Graduate Entrance Examinations in different courses of study.

Besides, the sponsored guideline the following guidelines have been laid down for issuing "No-objection Certificate" in respect of Medical Officers of Tripura Health Service and Tripura Medical Education Services under the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Tripura for appearing in Post Graduate Entrance Examinations in different courses of study in Medical Colleges in and outside the State as open category candidate.


2. The eligible criteria for 'No-Objection Certificate' are as under:-

- a) A candidate must be working under Tripura Health Services.
- b) Upper age limit shall be 45(forty five) years for UR candidates, 5(five) years relaxable for SC & ST candidates.
- c) Should be pursuing a PG course in any clinical/pre and para clinical subject from a MCI recognized Medical Institutions.

3. 'No-Objection Certificate' shall be valid for 1(one) year.

4. CONDITIONS.

- a) Open category candidate (regular & ad-hoc) will have to complete a minimum period of 6 (six) months service under this Department.
 - b) For sponsored category, candidates will have to complete 3(three) years of rural service, including 1(one) year in TTAADC areas.
 - c) In case of regular cadre of THS/TMES, release/admissible leave may be sanctioned as per Govt. norms if the candidate selected before sponsored criteria is fulfilled.
 - d) In case of regular cadre completed 3(three) years services but not fulfilled the sponsored criteria will be released/sanctioned admissible leave as per Govt. norms.
 - e) In case of ad-hoc, no Medical Officer of THS/TMES will be sanctioned any kind of leave except admissible leave if selected for PG course.
5. In the event of selection in Post Graduate course of study, candidates will have to execute necessary bond under this Department as per Memorandum NO.7(10)-DME/ET/2012, dated 30-10-2015.
6. No-Objection Certificate shall be issued by DHS for THS cadre and DME for TMES cadre after taking necessary approval from competent authority.

MEMORANDUM

Subject: Guideline for sponsorship of in service Medical Officer of THS under Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Tripura for admission in Post Graduate courses in the State and out-side the State and requirement of execution of Bond by all in service candidates.


In supersession of this Department's Memorandum No.F.11(2940)ET/MS/98 dated 31st January, 2001 issued in this regard, the following guidelines have been laid down for selection / sponsoring of Medical Officers of THS, Government of Tripura for open / sponsored category and also the requirement of execution of Bond by all in service candidates for admission to Post Graduate courses at Medical Colleges in the State and out-side the State.

1. The Candidate should have to qualify in Common Entrance Test (CET)/ NEET- PG examination amended from time to time for selection.
2. In service Medical Officers having 3 (three) years of rural service as per *ANNEXURE-I* can apply for the course as a sponsored category subject to condition that, the candidate should be confirmed by T.P.S.C. and will be eligible for sponsorship. However study leave shall not be granted to a Medical Officer who has rendered less than 5(five) years' service under the Government as per T.S.C.S.(Leave) Rules, 1986.
3. A Medical Officer having Post Graduate Diploma will be eligible for sponsorship only in the post graduate degree course of the same discipline or its allied disciplines after 3(three) years of obtaining Post Graduate Diploma.
4. If a Medical Officer, who is sponsored for study in Post Graduate Degree/ Diploma course fails to join the course, he/she would be debarred for sponsorship for the next 3 (three) years.
5. All in service candidates of Post Graduate/Super Specialty courses shall execute a bond in favor of the State Government stating that he/ she shall serve under the Government of Tripura for at least 5 (five) years immediately after successful completion of the course in case of PG Degree/ Super specialty and 3(three) years in case of PG Diploma.

6. In case, such candidate fails to serve under the Government of Tripura as per bond he/she will have to pay Rs. 35. Lakhs (Rupees Thirty five lakhs) for Pre & Para Clinical subject (Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology, Forensic Medicine & Community Medicine etc.) ,Rs.50.00 lakhs (Rupees Fifty lakhs) for all clinical subjects (Medicine, Surgery, Orthopedics, ENT, Obst. & Gynaccology. , Anesthesiology, Pediatrics, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, TB & Chest, Radio-diagnosis, Radiotherapy & Dermatology etc.) and Rs.70.00 lakhs (Rupees Seventy lakhs) for all Super Specialty course with interest accrued there on, subject to revision by the Government of Tripura from time to time.
7. All Post Graduate students (domicile or sponsored) should execute a bond stating that he/she will pay an amount of Rs.15.00 lakhs (Rupees Fifteen lakhs) for PG Diploma course, Rs.25.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty five lakhs) for PG Degree course and Rs.35.00 lakhs (Rupees Thirty five lakhs) for Super Specialty course , if he / she discontinues the course, subject to revision by the Government of Tripura from time to time.
8. In service sponsored candidates would be entitled to study leave , as per TSCS(Leave) Rules, 1986 and the remaining period shall be treated as training reserve during the period of PG study.
9. In-service candidate selected against open category having 3(three) years of Rural service will be treated as Training reserve during the total period of his / her study.


If Medical Officer sponsored for Super Specialty Course and do not have Study Leave in his/her credit, the total period of study shall be considered as Training Reserve.
10. Entrance for Post Graduate medical course recognized by MCI will come under these guidelines for sponsoring a candidate.
11. In the State quota PG seats the eligibility criteria for the sponsored/ open category shall be as follows:
 - i) Candidate should be of Tripura Health Services.
 - ii) The upper age limit shall be 45 (forty five) years.
 - iii) Sponsorship shall be sanctioned only in the MCI recognized post graduate courses as amended from time to time.

12. No. TA/DA etc. will be admissible to the sponsored / open category in service candidates during the period of the Postgraduate study.
13. Candidates selected for PG study will have to pay all expenses in connection with their Post Graduate Degree / Diploma studies and Govt. of Tripura will not bear the expenses incurred.
14. No-Objection Certificate, Sponsorship Certificate, Study Leave etc. for in service candidate of Tripura Health Services shall be dealt by the office of the Director of Health services.
15. Course fee for the whole 3(three) years course of PG/Super Specialty will be as per norms of the individual institute, both in the-state & outside the state.





In the PHCs belonging to Very difficult / remote area the Medical Officers and other staffs shall be posted there for 6(six) months (excluding leave period) by rotation with time bound auto release and in difficult areas the Medical Officers and other staff shall be posted there for 1(one) year (excluding leave period) by rotation with time bound auto release.

If any Medical Officer and other staff opt to continue his/her service beyond assured period at the categorized places then option may be left on his/her choice.

In case of Medical Officers, he/she will be given an opportunity to continue 3(three) years of rural service by transferring in another rural area, if he/she desires.
