Sub: Request to continue support state initiative towards availing deworming benefits to brickkilns workers and tea plantation workers in the age group of 1-19 years in the upcoming February 2020 round of National Deworming Day (NDD)

Dear Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am to inform you that National Deworming Day (NDD) is organized with collaborative efforts of the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Social Welfare and Social Education, School Education, Higher Education and Industries and commerce department with technical assistance from Evidence Action since 2015.

2. Deworming is significant for children as it improves their health (prevents anaemia, malnourishment, impaired mental and physical development) and leads to better education (improves attendance and retention of children in school and *anganwadis*) and livelihood opportunities (better adult outcomes and economic development) for them.

3. The state government continues to be committed to include more out-of-school children and hard to reach populations of the state into the program. A strong example of this drive has been the inclusion of out-of-school children (1 - 19 years) living in brickkiln communities since February 2017. The main challenge was deworming of this group due to seasonal activity, migratory in nature and coordination with brickkilns sites.

4. The state moves towards implementation of National Deworming Day on February 17, 2020 followed by mop-up day on February 24, 2020 in all *anganwadis* and schools (both government and private) across the state.

5. As per decision taken in the NDD State Coordination Committee Meeting held on December 27, 2019 reiterated the need for support from Directorate of Labour department for effective coverage of brickkilns sites and tea plantation workers across the state in the age group of 1-19 years in the upcoming National Deworming Day.

6. In this regard, you are requested for Issuance of directives from state to District Labour Department for providing necessary support and coordination with Health department for mobilization of brickkilns and tea plantation workers and attending meeting and training organize at district level for NDD.
