

**Media Bulletin on COVID 19, Dated:01.10.2020 Evening**

World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as Pandemic. Till now it has affected many countries/areas/territories, confirmed cases **3,37,22,075** people and caused **10,09,270** deaths. (source: - <https://covid19.who.int/> at 6.00 pm)

Till date in India, the Confirmed Cases are **63,12,584 (+86,821)**, **recovered 52,73,201 (+85,376)** including **98,678 (+1181) deaths**. The situation of Confirmed COVID-19 cases in North Eastern states: - Assam (**1,80,811**), Meghalaya (**5,639**), Manipur (**10,983**), Nagaland (**6,163**), Mizoram (**2,017**), Arunachal Pradesh (**9,796**), Sikkim (**3,012**). Till date in Tripura Active Cases are **5,184** and recovered **20,573**.
